INTRODUCTION

- A. How do you measure the growth of an individual?
 - 1. Physically height and weight.
 - 2. Mentally the knowledge we have (grades in school).
 - 3. Socially ability to interreact with others.
- B. Measuring the Growth of the Church.
 - 1. Maturing in faith.
 - 2. Also, when people are baptized into Christ and added to His body (numerically).
 - 3. They must be taught the gospel.
 - 4. Greatest opportunities occur among friends and family, NOT with the preacher.
 - 5. It must come from everyone.
- C. Example of the New Testament Church.
 - 1. Persecution of the church Christians scattered.
 - 2. As they scattered, they preached the good news, Acts 8:1, 4.
 - 3. The "who" is in reference to *Christians* scattered.
- D. But how does this happen?

I. WE MUST BELIEVE...

- A. ... That it is everybody's responsibility to teach.
 - 1. Commanded to teach.
 - a. Matthew 28:19-20
 - b. John 15:2
 - c. 1 Peter 2:9 proclaim the excellencies...
 - 2. Do we really believe this?
 - 3. We lean on the preacher or elders to do the job.
 - 4. We love our excuses, our free time, our comfort zone, with no intention of giving them up.
- B. Are you ready to accept this truth and believe it?

II. WE MUST REPENT...

- A. ... For Not Evangelizing.
 - 1. Many of us have been going to church for 40 to 50 years.
 - 2. We need to repent, decide to do differently, and change our ways.
 - 3. To say, "I'm not an evangelist" is an excuse.
 - 4. Not everyone may be an evangelist, but we all must evangelize.
 - 5. When was the last time:
 - a. you spoke to someone (other than family) about Christ? the church?
 - b. When was the last time you invited someone (other than F & F Day, VBS, or the gospel meeting) to worship?
- B. Are you ready to repent [change]?

III. WE MUST PRAY...

A. Our Need to Pray.

- 1. Ephesians 6:18-19
 - a. We must pray for courage.
 - b. We must pray for opportunity.
 - c. We must pray for vision to take advantage of the moment.
- 2. We must pray every day open our eyes to the harvest, Matthew 9:36-38.
- 3. When was the last time you prayed for the opportunity to teach...
- B. Are you ready to put forth this effort to pray?

IV. WE MUST PREPARE.

- A. Prepare to Evangelize.
 - 1. We must understand the gospel.
 - a. Its fullness of blessing.
 - b. Its demands.
 - c. 2 Timothy 2:15, not ashamed...handling accurately.
 - 2. We must understand those around us.
 - 3. We must have a plan, a method to know what to say, 1 Peter 3:15.
- B. Are you ready to prepare yourself?

V. WE MUST PRACTICE...

- A. What we practice.
 - 1. We must practice our faith.
 - 2. We must give [show] the example.
 - 3. We must show the presence of God and the character of Christ in our lives.
 - a. Ephesians 5:1
 - b. 1 Peter 2:21
 - c. Phil. 2:5
 - 4. Who wants to hear from a hypocrite?
 - 5. We must show in our life what we truly believe, Matthew 5:16.
- B. Are you ready to conduct yourself according to Christ?

CLOSING

- A. Fruit reproduces the plant.
 - 1. Jesus said it must die in order to sprout, John 12:24.
 - 2. We must die to ourselves in order that the gospel will grow in others, Gal. 2:20.
 - 3. Example without teaching is not enough.
 - a. No one was ever saved by example alone.
 - b. They must all be taught about God, Romans 10:17.
