INTRODUCTION

- A. Remember! From Santa Claus, the Movie.
- B. Reminders for daily chores.
 - 1. Post it notes, desk calendars.
 - 2. Apps providing alarms for meeting times, appointments, various reminders.
 - 3. Awards, pictures, plaques reminding of what has been and what can be.
- C. God used reminders for the Israelites.
 - 1. The ark of the covenant God's holiness and presence.
 - 2. Frontlets God's laws, Deuteronomy 6:8.
 - 3. Stone memorial crossing the Jordan, Joshua 4:8-9.

I. HISTORY OF EBENEZER, 1 Sam. 7.

- A. The Defeat of the Philistines.
 - 1. The Philistines first defeated Israel and captured the ark, 1 Sam. 4.
 - 2. After the ark was returned to Israel (from Philistines), 1 Sam. 6.
 - 3. Israel lamented after the Lord, vs. 2.
 - 4. Samuel instructed Israel to return to the Lord, v. 3.
 - a. Remove the foreign gods from among you.
 - b. Direct your hearts to the Lord and serve Him alone.
 - c. God will deliver you.
 - 5. The Philistines gathered to defeat Israel, v. 7.
 - 6. God won a great victory [thunder], v. 10.
- B. Ebenezer A Memorial Stone, vs. 12.
 - 1. A stone between Mizpah and Shen [about 5-8 miles north of Jerusalem].
 - 2. "Thus far the Lord has helped us."
 - 3. A reminder of God's victory over the Philistines.

II. WHAT ARE MY EBENEZERS?

- A. A Calendar.
 - 1. Specific dates mattered to Israel.
 - a. Special feast days Passover (Paschal Lamb), 1st month (Abib), 14th day.
 - b. The Sabbath.
 - 2. First day of the week.
 - a. Lord Supper, Acts 20:7.
 - b. Giving, 1 Corinthians 16:2.
 - c. Don't forsake the gathering, Hebrews 10:25.
- B. A Clock.
 - 1. Twenty-four-hour days, given by God to be used in the best way we can.
 - a. Daniel prayed 3 times each day, Daniel 6:10.
 - b. The psalmist, Psalm 55:17.
 - 2. We have the same twenty-four-hour day.
 - a. What do we do with it, Eph. 5:16?
 - b. Have we set aside a time each day to pray?
 - c. Have we set aside time each day to read and meditate on God's Word?
 - d. Do we make Sunday a day to honor and praise God?
 - 3. Neglecting this time (and worship time) leads to an emptiness and incomplete feeling in our lives.

C. A Place.

- 1. Someone has said, "A place is sacred when something holy happens there."
 - a. Bethlehem birth place of Jesus.
 - b. Cana first miracle.
 - c. Capernaum "home" of Jesus.
 - d. Nathanael didn't think much of Nazareth, John 1:46.
- 2. We hold special places:
 - a. Place we were baptized.
 - b. Place we were married.
 - c. Place where loved ones are buried.
- 3. We are drawn each Lord's Day to Calvary.
 - a. The blood of Jesus was shed for each of us, 1 Cor. 11:23-26.

D. A Person.

- 1. God made sure heroes of Israel's past were remembered:
 - a. Abraham
 - b. Isaac
 - c. Jacob
 - d. Joseph
 - e. David
 - f. Elijah
- 2. We are reminded of people teaching lessons for the church:
 - a. Peter denied Jesus.
 - b. John loved and was loved.
 - c. Judas the betrayer.
 - d. Barnabas the encourager.
 - e. Paul endured.
- 3. People in our lives as examples and encouragers:
 - a. Paul listed many in Romans 16.
 - b. Each of us have "heroes" in our lives for any number of reasons.
 - c. Couples who have touched our lives with living faith.
 - d. Individuals we would not want to disappoint.
