- B. The Lord's Church.
 - 1. Emphasis is on Acts 2:38, but believing and being baptized just the beginning!
 - 2. They were learning to walk like Jesus.
 - 3. Vss. 42-47 show a living picture of the early church.
 - 4. We are not left to guess as to what they did, how they lived.
 - 5. So, why do we do what we do?

I. UNWAVERING COMMITMENT, vs. 42.

- A. Steadfast in the Apostle's Teaching.
 - 1. They shared what they learned from Christ, committed to Matt. 28:20.
 - 2. The last book of the N.T. not completed until 66 yrs. later.
 - 3. Traditions taught, 2 Thess. 2:15.
- B. Fellowship [koinonia].
 - 1. To have in common or to share.
 - a. Galatians 6:6
 - b. Sharing a common bond, 1 John 1:3, 7.
 - i. With each other.
 - ii. And with God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit, 2 Cor. 13:14.
 - 2. Also, an *expression* of a common bond.
 - a. Communion, 1 Cor. 10:16.
 - b. Contribution [koinonia], Romans 15:26.
- C. Breaking Bread The Lord's Supper, 1 Cor. 11:23-26.
 - 1. In context with "worship" Lord's Supper.
- D. Prayer, Rom. 12:12 (description of love).

II. UNSELFISH IN COMPASSION.

- A. All Things in Common, vs. 44.
 - 1. Selling their property and possessions, vs. 45.
 - a. Not a command, but as the need arose.
 - b. Not everyone (because house to house, vs. 46).
 - 2. Day by day breaking bread, vs. 46.
- B. Meeting a Special Challenge.
 - 1. Jews from all over civilized world gathered for Pentecost.
 - 2. Many baptized lingered in Jerusalem.
 - a. Not prepared (money or food) for a long stay.
 - b. A unique opportunity for the early church.
 - 3. Acts 11:29 the famine in Judea (support of Christians in Antioch).

- 4. The attitude of Christians.
 - a. Stewards of God's possessions, Psalm 50:10-12; 1 Cor. 4:2.
 - b. 1 John 3:17
- 5. The benevolence of this congregation commended:
 - a. Change Cans.
 - b. Clothing Drive.
 - c. Flood Victims.

III. UNITED IN CHRIST.

- A. Met Daily In the Temple, Acts 2:46-47.
- B. Met from House to House.
 - 1. Breaking bread common meal.
 - 2. Taking their meals together.
 - 3. Sharing with gladness (not grumbling or complaining, Phil. 2:14).
 - 4. Sincerity [single-mindedness] of heart.
 - 5. John 13:34-35
 - 6. Ephesians 2:19-22
