 - 1. "To be, or not to be, that is the question:

Whether 'tis nobler in the mind to suffer

The slings and arrows of outrageous fortune,

Or to take Arms against a Sea of troubles,

And by opposing end them: to die, to sleep;

No more; and by a sleep, to say we end

The heart-ache, and the thousand natural shocks

That Flesh is heir to?"

- 2. Because of the weight and worry of the world, he was contemplating suicide.
- 3. What is the most important thing in life?
- B. Paul focuses on what the important thing in our life should be.
 - 1. Facing the weight and worry of the world.
 - 2. "To live is Christ, to die is gain."

I. LOOKING FOR THE GOOD IN ALL THINGS.

- A. The cause of Christ is better known, vss. 12-13.
 - 1. Paul had longed to go to Rome to preach, Rom. 1:10.
 - 2. Now he was there as a prisoner.
 - a. Praetorian guard.
 - i. Finest soldiers in the Roman army the Imperial Guard.
 - ii. Served as the emperor's private bodyguard.
 - iii. Assigned to guard Paul in 6-hour shifts [4 a day].
 - iv. In prison for his faith in Christ.
 - b. Everyone else others influenced by Paul.
 - i. Onesimus, runaway slave, Philemon 10-21.
 - ii. Members of Caesar's household, Phil. 4:22.
- B. Brethren have more courage to speak, vs. 14.
 - 1. After first imprisonment of apostles (Peter and John).
 - a. Acts 4:23, 27-30.
 - b. Place was shaken and Holy spirit filled.
 - c. They spoke with boldness.
 - 2. Trusting in the Lord. If Paul can, ...then so can I, vs. 16.
 - 3. So, Christ was proclaimed, vs. 18.
- C. Christ always exalted in the body, vs. 20.
 - 1. Always giving God the glory. All about Christ!
 - 2. Remember, "... you have been bought with a price:..." 1 Cor. 6:20.
 - 3. It is the Lord's work, Eph. 2:10.
 - 4. Phil. 2:13, "...for it is God who is at work in you, ..."
 - a. "At work..." energeo [energizes].
 - b. Lit., God gives the energy...

 - 1. Gal. 2:20
 - 2. Rom. 6:8-11
 - 3. Must bear fruit for God, Rom. 7:4.
- B. To Die is Gain, vs. 21.
 - 1. Depart and be with Christ.
 - a. 2 Tim. 4:6-8 already poured out.
 - 2. Have we become too attached to the world?
 - 3. Citizenship is in heaven, Phil. 3:20.
 - a. Example of the faithful.
 - b. Heb. 11:10, 13, 16.
 - 4. Footnote, v. 24 "to remain on is more necessary..."
- C. Conduct self in manner worthy of gospel, vss. 27-28.
 - 1. Standing firm in one spirit.
 - a. Early church one spirit and grew.
 - b. Acts 2:46
 - 2. One mind striving for the faith.
 - 3. Never alarmed by your opponent.
 - a. Strong in the Lord, Eph. 6:10.
 - b. Example of David facing Goliath, 1 Sam. 17:20ff
 - c. Rom. 8:31, 35
