- A. When paying bills, where do we put our trust?
 - 1. Maybe noticed when signing name to mortgage paper.
 - a. "Mort" "death," and "gage" "promise."
 - b. You've got it, "promise of death."
 - 2. It is out of our control!
 - 3. What makes us feel best, bottom line of account.
- B. Any assurance God works when financial future on line?
 - 1. I know in time of spiritual trouble, or physical harm, but...
 - 2. What about when it comes to our money affairs?

I. WHOM DO YOU REALLY TRUST?

- A. Case Number One.
 - 1. Moses speaking to the children of Israel, Deut. 8:2-5.
 - 2. You had nothing in wilderness, what did you learn?
 - a. They faced hunger, thirst, danger.
 - b. They survived the ordeal because of the hand of God.
 - 3. Based on trust in the Lord.
 - a. Vs. 1, keep His commands.
 - b. Vs. 2, tested to see whether or not...
 - c. Vs. 3, not live by bread alone, but by every word from the Lord.
- B. Case Number Two.
 - 1. Preparing to enter into land of Canaan, Deut. 8:7-10.
 - a. List of financial resources stated to Israelites.
 - b. How did it all come together?
 - 2. Vs. 10, God gave them all that was in the land. Bless the Lord!
 - 3. The entire nation was moving from slums to suburbs.
 - 4. Challenge still to be same as in wilderness, Deut. 8:1.
 - 5. Give control to the Lord.
- C. Case Number Three.
 - 1. What tends to happen when a nation begins to enjoy the "good" life?
 - a. A tendency to trust in themselves.
 - b. "Look what we have done...", Deut. 8:11-16.
 - . Moses warns the people of this danger, Deut. 8:17.
 - a. Don't forget God, vs. 11.
 - b. By not keeping His commands, v. 11.
 - 3. One word summarizes the case studies in Dt. 8, it is *control*.

II. TRUST IN GOD.

- A. Do We Recognize the Control of God?
 - 1. Rarely do we experience the situation found in Case Study #1.
 - 2. We have experienced the situation in Case Study #2 (and #3).
 - 3. Giving control to God, does not free us from economic decision.

- B. God's Control, Mt. 25:14-30.
 - 1. Management vs. leadership.
 - a. Management doing things right.
 Leadership doing the right things.
 - b. Management sees to getting the business up the ladder. Leadership – makes sure the ladder is on the right wall.
 - c. Management cuts the path through the jungle. Leadership – makes sure the path goes in the right direction.
 - 2. God leads, controls, picks the wall, sets the direction.
 - 3. It is up to us to manage, set schedules, route paperwork, and set policies.
 - 4. God is watching over us.
 - a. Ps. 9:10 Thou hast not forsaken those who seek...
 - b. Ps. 94:14 He will not abandon His people...
 - c. Ps. 121:3 He who keeps will not slumber...
 - d. Mt. 6:33 Seek first His kingdom...
