Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone." (Romans 12:9-18) When we treat each other the way scripture teaches us to we become the true family of God. True love means taking an active interest in the lives of those who are in your family. Love is a decision to act in accordance with the will of God.
